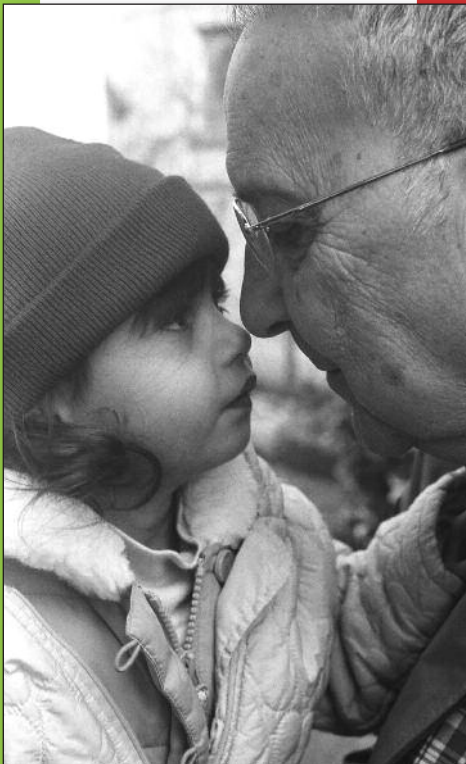

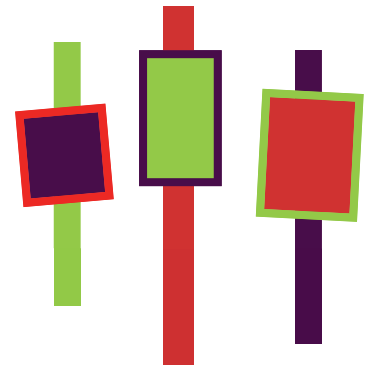

# Guidelines for the Contest



GU, with generous support from **MetLife Foundation's Healthy Aging Initiative**, is holding a contest for young and old amateur photographers. The contest is for the best photograph taken by a younger or older person of younger and older people together, and should demonstrate the importance of intergenerational connections. The winning photos are often candid shots of intergenerational relationships in action. Plan intergenerational activities where younger and older participants are taking photographs to gather entries.

## Purpose:

- To capture the power and beauty of intergenerational relationships in action and convey the important roles that younger and older people play in each other's lives

## Leading Categories:

- Celebration of diversity
- Emotional expression
- Humorous situations
- Intergenerational activity portrayed

## Deadlines:

- All mailed entries must be postmarked to GU by April 1, 2009 in order to be considered for the contest.
- Electronic submissions must be received by midnight on April 1, 2009.
- Winners will be notified no later than 2 months after the deadline.

## Prizes:

- Grand Prize: \$250 and a trip to Washington, DC in July to attend GU's Awards Banquet
- Second place: \$100
- Third place: \$50
- Honorable Mentions will be awarded in the four leading categories.
- All winners whose photographs are used in any GU product will receive credit for the photograph.

## Photograph Standards:

- Photographs can be either color or black and white.
- All digital entries must be high quality digital 300 dpi jpeg format.
- Photographs submitted with contest entry become the property of Generations United and will not be returned.
- Take care with mailed photographs (Use plastic sleeves, tissue paper, cardstock, etc. to protect quality of photo.)

## Eligibility:

- Contest is open to children and youth up to 23 years of age, and adults over the age of 50.
- All completed entries received by April 1, 2009 will be considered for the contest.
- Photos taken by professional photographers (individuals who have ever been paid for their photos) are **NOT** eligible.
- Each contestant may enter no more than **3** photographs.
